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The FMA Roads Committee serves as a point-of-contact for exchange of information with Sonoma County Transportation and Public Works' Roads Division.

The Fitch Mountain residents who live in the unincorporated County rely on County TPW for the maintenance of most of our roads. The safety of our residents depends on regular upkeep of these roads and rapid response when emergencies block or hinder safe passage. The FMA Roads Committee members can serve as eyes-on-the-ground for the County when emergencies occur and help disseminate information to residents about repairs that are underway and planned.

The Roads Committee will advocate in the best interests of the Fitch Mountain community's safety and raise issues with our collaborating agencies if we feel that these interests are not being sufficiently weighed. For example: needed or unnecessary signage, installation of traffic calming measures, etc. that have an impact on the natural environment and character of Fitch Mountain.

Meeting Schedule: Quarterly meetings with TPW, ad hoc internal meetings when warranted.

FMA Status: This is a committee
